THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF EAST ST. PAUL

BY-LAW NO. 2022-05

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of East St. Paul to appoint and to fix and provide for the remuneration of a senior election official and other election positions.

WHEREAS the Municipal Councils and School Board Elections Act C.C.S.M. c M257 providing in part as follows:

- 10(1) Each elected authority must appoint a senior election official (SEO) and may provide for his or her remuneration;
- 10(3) A senior election official, unless he or she sooner resigns, dies or ceases to be eligible under subsection 17(1), holds office until his or her successor is appointed;
- 12(1) A senior election official may appoint an assistant senior elections official;

and

- 13(1) The senior election official may appoint one or more
 - (a) election officials; and
 - (b) supervising election officials, to supervise other election officials.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and necessary to appoint a Senior Election Official and other election officials as required to fix an provide for remuneration of those duties

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of East St Paul enact as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Heidi Speirs be appointed the Senior Election Official at a remuneration of \$1,400 per month during the election period defined as April 1st to October 31st of any given election year, or similar time period as required for conducting a bi-election pertinent to the appointed SEO.
- 2. **THAT** Council will provide remuneration at an hourly rate of \$65.00 for SEO duties including administration of the voters list, registration and nomination days, advance poll and election days, post-election responsibilities, judicial recounts and/or appeals, candidate registration.
- 3. **THAT** Council shall reimburse the SEO for each kilometer actually travelled in the performance of the duties of the SEO consistent with that defined within the Indemnity By-law NO. 2022-01. The SEO is required to record and present a travel expense sheet to Council for their review and approval prior to payment being issued for mileage expenses.
- 4. **THAT** Council will provide reimbursement upon provision of proof of payment, for any legitimate and required increase to the SEO's vehicle insurance during the election period defined as April 1st to October 31st of any given election year, or similar time period as required for conducting a bi-election pertinent to the appointed SEO.
- 5. **THAT** Council will provide remuneration at the rates set out in the Indemnity By-law NO. 2022-01 for required SEO training courses or programs.
- 6. **THAT** Council shall reimburse the SEO actual costs, upon presentation of proof of payment for a cell phone available and used during the election period defined as April 1st to October 31st of

- any given election year or similar time period as required for conducting a bi-election pertinent to the appointed SEO.
- **7. THAT** Council will provide a meal allowance to the SEO consistent with that defined within the Indemnity By-law NO. 2022-01.
- **8. THAT** the Senior Elections Official appoint the Assistant Senior Election Officer at a remuneration of \$40.00 per hour, and provide a meal allowance and remuneration for required elections related training consistent with that defined within the Indemnity By-law NO. 2022-01.
- 9. **THAT** the senior Elections Official appoint the Enumerator at the remuneration which shall be set at \$40.00 per hour and remuneration for required elections related training consistent with that defined within the Indemnity By-law NO. 2022-01.
- 10. **THAT** the Senior Election Official appoint the Voting Official(s) at a remuneration which shall be set at \$20.00 per hour.
- 11. **THAT** the Senior Elections Official appoint the Voting Clerk(s) for the advance and regular polls at a remuneration which shall be set at \$17.00 per hour.
- 12. **THAT** the Voting Officials and the Voting Clerks be authorized a meal allowance of \$15.00 for lunch and \$20.00 for dinner during the day(s) they are engaged in active polling.
- 13. THAT all staff hired specific to election activity be reimburse for each kilometer actually travelled in the performance of their election-related duties consistent with that defined within the Indemnity By-law NO. 2022-01. Each staff person is required to record and present a travel expense sheet to the SEO for their review and approval prior to payment being issued for mileage expenses.
- 14. **THAT** this by-law shall supersede any previous selection appointments mentioned above and shall come into effect on the day that it is passed by Council.
