PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to enhance pedestrian facilities, with providing measures that would give people an improved opportunity to walk within the municipality.

POLICY

1. The RM of East St. Paul will maintain all gravel pathways located in a municipal owned property, for three (3) seasons (spring, summer, and fall) annually.
2. Typically, no snow clearing will be done on any gravel pathways.
3. The RM of East St. Paul will make routine inspections of all gravel pathways on a regular basis. Inspections will be done on a monthly basis, following intense rainfall (or spring runoff), or after receiving a complaint from a resident.
4. The RM of East St. Paul will be responsible to carry out all repairs to all existing gravel pathways to a condition that will provide a safe environment to all pedestrians.
5. No person shall sprinkle water on any municipal gravel pathway.
